Our Three's and Four's have been getting ready for our Christmas Sing-a-Long. The halls have been filled with music! The fours letters this month are J, K . and the theme is the Holidays. Take a look at what the Fours are asking Santa for this year (on their bulletin board). You may be surprised.

The Two's and Three's are also concentrating on teaching the children about the holidays. The classes are practicing counting objects up to 5 (3 in the Two's class). You can help at home by asking your child to tell you a letter on a sign or label. Kids love to 'show off' their newly acquired knowledge. So instead of asking them "What did you do today" try to be more specific. "Can you teach me about this work that you did, that I found in your back-pack?" or "Tell me some of the 'K'
